# 2018 Ohio Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) Showcase

## Call for Presenters and Posters

School leadership team implementers are encouraged to plan for sharing practical examples and resources for efficient, effective and sustained implementation of systemic and systematic PBIS to assist educators across all of Ohio's school communities. Districts may opt to do a presentation or a poster session.

Presentations and Posters must fit into one of these strands:

- A. Early Childhood
- B. Community and Family Partnerships
- C. Elementary
- D. Middle School/High School
- E. Tier II/Tier III Practices (strongly encouraged for Silver/Gold award recipients)
- F. PBIS at the District Level

In addition, quality proposals are those in which presenters have implemented strategies in the Ohio PBIS framework and can share documented evidence of effectiveness. Also, the session will include participant interaction that promotes good adult learning by showing effective strategies and practices that can work in session attendees' school/district.

**DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION: Wednesday, September 21, 2018, at midnight.**

### Presenter Information

- Submit sessions outlining practical strategies and resources that attendees can easily adopt or incorporate into their schools' existing PBIS framework and action plan.
- Propose up to four presenters per session – one lead presenter and up to three co-presenters.
- Plan for a 50 minute session.
- You may submit more than one proposal for consideration.
- Review the [Scoring Rubric](#) that scorers in the blind review will use prior to submitting a proposal.

- Create a visual, table top display board of PBIS in your school/district to generate a fun and informal discussion about practices.
- Describe specific practices or implementation procedures used in your school/district.
- Include data documenting implementation and/or impact on children.

- Handouts recommended and the responsibility of the presenter.
