- An agreement that outlines services that both the SST and the district/school will engage in throughout the current year.
- An agreement that uses information from a district's/school's One Plan and multiple data sources to determine areas of focus.
- (Note: 10.5) Key components of an SDA include services, district & SST actions, persons responsible, and success criteria.
- A fluid document that is jointly reviewed at least three times a year.
